Nominations for Farmer of the Year



Do you know anyone who has devoted their life to agriculture for more than twenty-five (25) years and has also been a resident of Juniata County during those same years? That person may be our next “Farmer of the Year”. You will need to write a description telling why this person should be considered for “Farmer of the Year”. Be sure to include what makes this person different from other farmers who live in the Juniata County area.

The nominee will be honored on Sunday, September 2, 2018, at 5:30 pm in the George Settlemyer Livestock Barn. If someone has been nominated in the past, but didn't win, they can be nominated again.

All entries are judged by a point system, so be very detailed with your nomination.

We created this award because our fair has had an agricultural focus since its beginning. Farming community surrounds the Juniata County Fairgrounds. Ask a farmer why they want to farm? They will tell you it is being part of the 59,000 farm families in Pennsylvania who continue to be the stewards of over 7.7 million acres of farmland.
